On February 23, 2024, the so-called 13th package of sanctions against Russia was adopted, with the publication in the Official Journal of the European Union of Regulation (EU) 2024/745 ("Reg. 2024/745"), which amends Regulation (EU) No. 833/2014 ("Reg. 833/2014") came into force on February 24, 2024, and Implementing Regulation (EU) 2024/753 ("Reg. 2024/753"), which amends Regulation (EU) 269/2014 ("Reg. 269/2014") came into force on February 23, 2024, expanding the existing bans on the import of steel products by prohibiting, from February 24, 2024, the direct or indirect import or purchase of the steel products listed in Annex XVII, which have been processed in a third country and incorporate steel products originating from Russia listed in Annex XVII.

Similar regulations have also been adopted by the United Kingdom – Russia (Sanctions Eu Exit – Amendment Regulation 46IA and 46IB, introduced in Chapter 4CA of Part 5 of the aforementioned Regulations 2023, as well as by the Swiss Federal Council with the new text of Article 14 of the Swiss Ordinance establishing measures in relation to the situation in Ukraine (Ordinance No. 946.231.173.72).

Regarding the products manufactured in its facilities, they do not originate from Russia, nor do they incorporate steel products originating from Russia, and therefore comply with the provisions set out in the aforementioned regulations.
